

### Mural Bike Rack

**Program** is the newest addition to the Mayor's Office of Cultural Affairs and Department of City Planning Public Art Service Programs. The project provides the opportunity for three community artists to design and paint locally crafted bike-shaped racks. The bike racks will be installed within the Cascade Heights business district.

A panel of artists, residents, and city staff selected the winning designs which are displayed on this board.

The artists will have the winter months to paint the bike-shaped racks and then they will be installed in early March.

The mural bike-shaped racks will provide a safe and secure place for people to lock their bicycles. Bike parking encourages people to bike and shows that adjacent businesses value sustainability and alternative forms of transportation.
